

## Review of the Alanis Morissette CD Under Rug Swept

The exceptionally talented Rock artist Alanis Morissette has released her CD entitled Under Rug Swept. I am very confident and happy to announce that I believe Alanis Morissette fans, and Rock fans alike will be pleased with this one. With the release of Under Rug Swept Alanis Morissette's artistic excellence is on full display as Morissette has once again delivered a brilliant collection of tracks that could very well be her best work to date.
