They offer a very cost effective ANNUAL plan, where if you pay a year in advance, the monthly cost of your VOIP service drops to around \$17 per month. If you are a bit more cautious and want to make sure it works well first, even the monthly plan is under \$20 per month. This includes unlimited calling in the United States and Canada. It also has super-low international rates, such as Australia at 1.9 cents per minute, China at 1.6 cents per minute, United Kingdom at 1.6 cents per minute, and similarly superb rates elsewhere in the world.

Be aware of what you need and realize that there is no sense in spending more for features that you won't use. Be a smart consumer and comparison shop, and make sure you are looking at the features that you will use regularly.
