During this time, Davis was trying to get the Raiders' stadium improved and when that didn't materialize, he decided to move the team to Los Angeles. Fans were furious; after all, these were the people who had lined up for Oakland Raiders tickets for so many years. Despite the protests, the team was moved and the Los Angeles Raiders were born. Off the field, the move was marked by a number of internal quarrels that would brew on and off over the next few years. In 1995, the team was finally shifted back to Oakland.

The team was greeted with high Oakland Raiders tickets sales and jubilation from the fans. The Raiders seemed happy to be home and played consistently, though the glory of their early days was definitely lacking. In 2001, the team was involved in a famous controversial play called The Tuck in a game against the Patriots. However in 2006 the Raiders pulled in their worst record since 1962. The team is currently trying to improve its offensive line up which is generally seen as the Raiders' weakest game point.
