In the steam carpet cleaning method, professionals spray a water solution mixed with detergent over the carpet. Then a vacuum cleaner is used to remove the water and soil together.

Many professional cleaners use a truck-mount vacuum machine to extricate the soils from the carpet, or else, they may also count on small and portable vacuum machine which can be carried over to the home or office. Nevertheless, the truck-mounted system is the most common because it provides a better cleaning.
