The law states that you must have rest time of at least eleven hours per day, uninterrupted! Many city workers don't get anywhere near that much! So you are well protected by laws which ensure that your hours are fair.

Training for a basic LGV license can take as little as five days! Then you are fully qualified and ready to go. What other job gives you qualifications that translate directly into jobs with high salaries within that kind of time scale? Haulage companies are facing a shortage of lorry drivers so it puts you in a very commanding position when job hunting.
